
Our church is in good shape financially.

How did we do on spending?

Operating funds

\$15,767 under budget

\$ 139,726

- Reduced operations & mild winter kept costs down.
- Lower expenses more than offset lower-than-budgeted revenues.

Campus Ministry expenses \$2,319 under budget \$ 681

Capital Expenditures \$4,040 under budget \$5,960

Pergola costs so far covered by purpose-restricted memorial funds \$ 4,710

Other Restricted Expenditures \$ 1,671

Capital Fund's Ins and Outs

- \$14,122 pledge receipts, \$800 gift, \$4,733 energy rebate (vicarage)
- \$4,000 budgeted for contingencies wasn't spent.
- \$5,960 was spent in Jan '20 for 2nd half due on Dec '19 vicarage reroofing





Memorial Pergola – Special Capital Project

- \$9,420 pergola built in December
- Lead gifts made in memory of Sean Tully
- Paid 1st half upfront from \$6,035 raised in 2020
- Paid 2nd half (\$4,210) in January 2021



Matching funds challenge & more memorializing opportunities ahead

Capital Budget for 2021

\$15,000-\$17,000 anticipated from 29 new capital pledges

• To be added to \$26,765 fund balance at 12/31/2020

Hopes for \$5,000+ from new gifts restricted for the memorial pergola and related landscaping & signs

• To be added to \$1,325 pergola-restricted fund balance at 12/31/2020

\$23,200 in planned expenditures, including pergola:

- \$5,000 for final payment on pergola and some seeding or signs
- \$16,000 for vicarage windows' replacement (30% more will be needed per bids)
- \$1,200 for AV equipment and \$1,000 for contingencies

Operating budget for 2021 will use less than 10% of the large surplus from 2020.

Revenues = \$143,300

Expenses = \$145,900

Planned Deficit = \$2,600



Major assumptions in 2021 Operating Budget

- 47 pledges totaling \$105,360 will cover \$104,000 budgeted in the 2021 operating budget that the Bishop's Committee approved last month.
- Plate, fundraising, and building use revenue expectations are similar to actual 2020 revenues due to persistence of pandemic.
- Pay raises will be given to the Vicar, Music Director, and Office Staff.
- Utility increases are predicted to be close to 20%.
- Interest income will be down due to lower rates available on money market, savings, certificates of deposit, and other non-stock investments.
- St. A's should still end 2021 with more unrestricted funds than it started 2020, equal to more than one year of operating expenses.
